## A. NATURE & SCOPE

The Outdoor Centre is looking for active, enthusiastic youth leaders to introduce participants to fun and exciting outdoor activities! This position is responsible for providing a fun and safe learning environment for participants (grades 2-8) in a variety of activities such as mountain biking, stand-up paddleboarding, rafting, hiking, fishing, survival skills, and outdoor photography. Camp locations will include both urban and backcountry settings, with most of the time spent in the Kananaskis area. Leaders will be responsible for driving a 15-passenger van to and from locations, occasionally towing small trailers. Get paid to be outside while staying active and having fun!

## B. CHARACTERISTIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Be available to participate in staff orientation and training
- Implement activities and adapt to a variety of ability and experience levels
- Provide quality care, fun, and supervision to all participants
- Provide first aid treatment when necessary and document care in accordance with Outdoor Centre emergency procedures
- Responsible for the transportation of participants in a university vehicle
- Provide weekly written reports to the Youth Program Coordinator
- Abide by Youth Programs' and the Outdoor Center's Policies and Procedures

## C. QUALIFICATIONS

- General knowledge and experience in some or all of the mentioned activities
- Well-developed leadership skills and a passion for introducing youth to the outdoors
- Experience and/or educational training working with youth ages 7-14
- Available and willing to work Monday to Friday from 7:30am to 4:00pm
- Valid (or intent to get) Wilderness First Aid (40-hour minimum) and CPR
- Valid (or intent to get) Class 4 Driver's License
- To drive for the university, you must be 21 years or older and have a clean driving record
- Valid (or intent to get) Police Check for the Vulnerable Sector
- Valid (or intent to get) Outdoor Council of Canada's Field Leader (Hiking) certification

Certifications will be subsidized after successful completion of the contract
